

Iraq War Supplemental Spending:
Assessing Voting Factions in the House of Representatives

Congress is now considering President Bush's request for an additional \$102.5 billion in supplemental spending for the Iraq – Afghanistan wars. The central objectives of the antiwar effort must continue to be an end to all funding for the war in Iraq; an end to all military action against Iraq; and the complete and immediate withdrawal of all U.S. military forces from Iraq.

At the same time, it is important to examine the recent voting records of Representatives. An assessment of voting records will assist in developing strategies and tactics to use in lobbying Representatives to bring the Iraq war to an end. These strategies will no doubt include both legal and extralegal (i.e., nonviolent civil disobedience and nonviolent civil resistance) forms of lobbying.

The following assessments should be used as a tool in developing lobbying strategies rather than as the “be all, end all” assessment of Representatives and there are varying degrees of support or opposition to the Iraq war within each grouping that follows.

KEY VOTES – 2007

4 key votes were examined in developing this assessment of the voting records of members of the House of Representatives.

HR 2237 – Representative Jim McGovern's bill that established a timetable for the partial withdrawal of U.S. troops from Iraq. May 2007 vote.

HR 2206 – The May 2007 Iraq – Afghanistan war supplemental that passed and became law. It did not contain a timetable for partial withdrawal.

HR 4156 – The November 2007 Iraq – Afghanistan war supplemental that passed the House but failed in the Senate. It contained language for a partial withdrawal.

HR 2764 – The December 2007 Iraq – Afghanistan war supplemental that passed and became law. It does not contain a timetable for partial withdrawal.

POINT SYSTEM USED

In developing a legislative strategy to end Iraq war funding, it is important to assess the relative strengths and weaknesses within Congress. Who are our strongest allies? Who are secondary allies? Who are the fence sitters? Who is staunchly opposed to our position?

In attempting to assess these factions within Congress, a very basic point system was used.

+1 "YES" vote on HR 2237

+1 "YES" vote on HR 4156

+2 "NO" vote on HR 4156 – but only if the person consistently voted against Iraq war funding otherwise. (Thomas Allen; John Duncan; Mike Michaud; and Pete Stark are the only four Representatives in this highly worthy category.)

+1 "NO" vote on HR 2206

+1 "NO" vote on HR 2764

-1 "NO" vote on HR 2237

-1 "NO" vote on HR 4156

-1 "YES" vote on HR 2206

-1 "YES" vote on HR 2764

No points were assessed if the person did not vote.

GROUP 1

138 Representatives who in 2007 established a track record of voting only for Iraq war supplemental spending measures which include the now standard position of a partial troop withdrawal from Iraq. This partial troop withdrawal would leave U.S. forces in Iraq for purposes of: protecting the U.S. Embassy and U.S. personnel; training the Iraqi military and police; and engaging in counter-terrorist activities. In June 2007, the Center for a New American Security issued a report which lays out essentially this same force structure and concludes that 50,000 to 60,000 U.S. troops would remain in Iraq through at least the end of 2011.

These 138 Representatives should be pressured to, at a minimum, continue to vote against any funding which does not also require the withdrawal of U.S. troops from Iraq.

But this should only be a starting point for lobbying these 138 Representatives. They should also be pressured to take the next step and publicly commit to opposing any additional funds for the Iraq war other than those required to effect a safe and immediate withdrawal of all U.S. troops from Iraq.

GROUP 2

17 Representatives who have a mixed voting record in 2007. These Representatives share two votes in common. Each voted in favor of HR 4156, the November supplemental that contained provisions for troop withdrawal. Each also voted against the final version of the supplemental (HR 2764) in December which did not have any troop withdrawal provisions.

These 17 Representatives may require stronger lobbying efforts than those in Group 1 to continue to vote against Iraq war funding that comes without any withdrawal provisions. These 17 should also be lobbied to take the next step to vote against all funding for the Iraq war other than that required for the safe and immediate withdrawal of all U.S. troops from Iraq.

GROUP 3

23 Representatives who move us into a swing category. All but one (who did not vote) voted in favor of HR 2237 in May, the McGovern bill on partial withdrawal. All 23 voted in favor of HR 4156 (the November supplemental with withdrawal language). But 19 voted in favor of HR 2206, the May supplemental lacking withdrawal language. All 23 voted in favor of HR 2764, the December supplemental which also lacked withdrawal language.

These 23 Representatives therefore have demonstrated that they will support legislation that contains partial withdrawal language. The most immediate task is to move them to voting against funds which do not contain partial withdrawal language. The next step after that is to pressure each to vote against all funding for the Iraq war other than that necessary for the safe and immediate withdrawal of all U.S. troops from Iraq.

GROUP 4

Group 4 – 50 Representatives. This may be THE block of Representatives to be lobbied hard and fast to end funding for the Iraq war. There are 178 Representatives in the first three groups. Add in these 50 Representatives and you get to 228, which gives a razor thin margin of 10 Representatives for a potential majority vote.

Each of these 50 Representatives voted against HR 2206, the McGovern partial withdrawal bill. Each voted in favor of each of the supplemental spending bills. This includes the two that did not include partial withdrawal language (in May and December) as well as the one that included partial withdrawal language (in November).

There was a change in their voting posture from May to November—opposing partial withdrawal in May while voting in favor of a spending bill with partial withdrawal in November.

However, because of the consistency of votes in support of war spending—with or without partial withdrawal language—this is the swing group to perhaps work the hardest to get to change their positions on war spending.

It will be difficult, but work should be done to move this group of 50 to vote only for Iraq war spending which contains clear troop withdrawal language and to vote against any other form of Iraq war spending. The next step will then be to pressure each person to vote against any additional war funding other than necessary to safely and immediately withdraw all U.S. troops from Iraq.

GROUP 5

203 Representatives who (if in office at the time of the vote) almost uniformly voted against the McGovern bill with partial withdrawal and against the November war supplemental with partial troop withdrawal. These 203 also voted in favor of the war supplemental in May and December which did not have any form of partial withdrawal language.

This block of 203 currently need pull only 15 votes from the swing voting block in order to pass a war supplemental that does not contain partial withdrawal language.

It is possible that Representative David Obey could use his power as Chair of the House Appropriations Committee to prevent a supplemental spending bill from going to the floor of the House for a vote. It is also possible that Speaker Nancy Pelosi could use her power as Speaker in the same manner. However, should either Obey or Pelosi use their power in such a manner on a war supplemental spending bill, it is entirely probable that Representative Jerry Lewis or Representative Bill Young (both Republicans on the House Appropriations Committee) would introduce their own version of a supplemental spending bill (and most likely without any partial withdrawal language). If their bill is bottled up by Obey and / or Pelosi, then they would most probably circulate a discharge petition. As soon as a majority of Representatives—218—sign the discharge petition, the supplemental spending bill is brought to the floor of the House for a vote. Again, there is the block of 203 Representatives who could reasonably be expected to sign a discharge petition, meaning they would need to find only another 15 Representatives to sign the discharge petition to force a vote on the supplemental spending bill by the full House of Representatives.
